Signing Up for and Using the HOTBears Yahoo! Group

Hi there Bears! This is Jack Landers, one of the co-moderators of the HOTBears Yahoo! Group. This article is intended to help you through the process of joining the HOTBears Yahoo! Group. If you're already a member, then post a message! ☺

The HOTBears Yahoo! Group is simply a discussion forum set up for the Heart of Texas Bears. It's a way for our members to interact and share ideas "off the calendar" or informally. The messages are still available at the group, so look through them and see how people have used the list. Some have simply talked about things, others have invited their fellow bears to an outing they have decided to spearhead. It's a great way to keep in touch with your fellow HOT Bear members.

Setting Up a Yahoo! ID

If you already have a Yahoo! ID, then skip this section and go to the "Join The HOTBears Yahoo! Group with your Yahoo! ID" section to join the group.

Register for a Yahoo ID: First, go to groups.yahoo.com. At the top, under sign in, it says "New User?" and there's a link beside it that says "Sign Up". Click the "Sign Up" link and fill in the following information:

Create Your Yahoo! ID: First Name, Last Name, Preferred Content (US, other countries) and Gender. These are pretty self-explanatory. Just fill them in.

Yahoo! ID: This is your sign-in name for Yahoo! Groups, and will show beside any messages you post. Remember this name.

Password & Re-type password: This is the password you will use to sign-in to Yahoo Groups. Remember this password.

Yahoo! Mail: Uncheck this box if you don't want another email address.

If You Forget Your Password...: In this section, you will provide your Security Question and answer, your birthday and zip/postal code along with an alternate email address. Yahoo uses this information if you have forgotten your password, and they need to reset and/or email your password to you.

Note that the "alternate email address" also becomes your primary email address for this account. Use the email address where you want your HOTBears Yahoo! Group messages sent. This must be a valid active account. When you have signed up, Yahoo will send an email there that you will need to read and respond to in order to complete your registration. The response is clicking on a link in the email, that will bring you to the Yahoo web pages and validate your account.

Customizing Yahoo!: All the items in this section are optional. Fill them in if you like.

Verify Your Registration: Here you will see a graphic with a word, and the letters will be distorted. Read the word in the graphic as best you can, and type it in the box. This feature is used to prevent automated programs from using this page.

Read the terms of service, then click the "I Agree" button to create an account. If there have been any problems (The Yahoo ID is not available, etc), then correct the errors and try again. When you are successful, you will see a confirmation page. Print this for your records.

When you are finished, go check your email account, and respond to the message from Yahoo (click on the link in the email to validate your account).

Next, sign in to your account, and find the "My Account" link (usually next to the "Sign Out" link). Be sure to check the settings for your account, and especially the "Edit Your Marketing Preferences" under the "Member Information" section. This is where you can **uncheck** all the notices you've been automatically subscribed to when you signed up for your Yahoo ID.

Join the HOTBears Yahoo! Group with your Yahoo! ID

Go to this page to join the group: groups.yahoo.com/group/HOTBears/join

Note that this is an "Age Restricted Area" of Yahoo Groups. You may need to click on an "I Accept" button to acknowledge you are over 18 years of age. Once you are there, you'll have to fill out the following sections:

Yahoo! Profile: Choose the profile you will use for this group. If you have just joined, or have only one profile, then that one will be selected. You may also add a new profile here.

Email Address: Choose the email address you will use for this group. If you have just joined, or have only one email address defined, then it will be selected. You may also add a new email address here. This is the email address that will receive emails, digests and special notices to the group.

Comment To Owner: This section will appear if you are signing up, but not responding to an invitation to join the group (more on that later). In this section, please tell us your First and Last name, and the email address you provided when you joined the Heart Of Texas Bears (not the Yahoo! Group, the club). What we're looking for here is enough information to validate that you are a current member of the Heart Of Texas Bears. Additional identifying information will be appreciated. We must have enough information about you to verify your HOT Bears membership. If we cannot identify you as a current member of the HOT Bears, then we will send you an email (from CommBear@HeartOfTexasBears.org) to ask for additional information. If you are not a current member of the HOT Bears, then you will be denied membership in the HOTBears Yahoo! Group.

Message Delivery: Here is where you choose how your messages will be delivered. When you choose "Individual email", then each email posted to the group will be reflected to your email address. When you choose "Daily Digest", then a digest of messages will be sent periodically to your email. If you choose "Special notices", then only special notices will be sent to your email address. Finally, if you choose "No Email", then no messages will be sent to your email address. Instead, you will have to go to the web page for the group (groups.yahoo.com/group/HOTBears) to read the messages that have been posted.

Message Format: This is where you choose the format of the email you receive from the group. If you choose "Do not convert to HTML", then no conversion is done on your email before it is sent to you. If you choose "Convert to HTML", then the messages are formatted like a web page with color and

graphics before they are sent to you.

Word Verification: Here you will see a graphic with a word, and the letters will be distorted. Read the word in the graphic as best you can, and type it in the box. This feature is used to prevent automated programs from using this page.

Click on the "Join" button, and you will be queued for approval to join. The moderators will approve you as soon as they can, and you will receive a confirmation email.

Join the HOTBears Yahoo! Group without a Yahoo! ID

If you wish to subscribe without setting up a Yahoo! ID, then you may send an email to HOTBears-subscribe@yahogroups.com (include the hyphen in the address). In the email, please include your first and last name, and the email address you provided when you joined the HOT Bears. This will allow the moderators to verify that you are a current member of the Heart Of Texas Bears and approve your subscription. (See "Comment To Owner", above)

Note that when you subscribe in this mode (without a Yahoo! ID), you will not be able to select digest or use the group web features. Yahoo! Groups web features include:

- Message management — easily control the frequency of email messages you receive.
- Membership management — easily join or leave groups, all in one place.

- More — get access to message archives, photos, files, calendars, polls and more.

Note that if you use this e-mail subscription method, you will be queued for approval to join. The moderators will approve you as soon as they can.

Join the HOTBears Yahoo! Group using an invitation

Finally, you may have been sent an invitation to join the group via email from the moderator of the HOTBears Group (for example, when you join the HOT Bears for the first time). Just follow the instructions on the invitation to join using your Yahoo! ID. If you don't already have a Yahoo! ID, you'll be given an opportunity to create one. Since you are pre-approved by the invitation, you become a member of the group immediately. The invitation expires in seven days.

If you have any problems joining the new HOTBears Yahoo! Group, then please contact the moderator of the group at CommBear@HeartOfTexasBears.org. The Communications Bears and HOTBears Yahoo! Group moderators will do their best to assist!

We certainly hope you will join the discussion among your fellow HOT Bears and look forward to reading your contributions.

Back to the Woods Deadline!

Hey men! You have only a short time to register for Heart of Texas Bears- Back to the Woods (October 7-9). In order to have as many HOT Bear Members at the run, I am extending, to members only, the early registration date to September 23. After that, the fee jumps to \$110 cash only at the gate. Remember- this is for H.O.T. Bear members only. At the time of this writing, we are 60% full and applications are coming in on a regular basis. The cut off is 100 men (but there can be exceptions, so don't give up).

News from Buzzards Peak

There was a quarterly Texas Conference of Clubs board meeting in July. I attended as the HOT Bears delegate and was required to vote on several key issues concerning management of the land and fees imposed on permanent campers. There was also the introduction of the new bylaws that will simplify decision making. As you might know, the TCC is made up of almost 20 clubs from around Texas, as well as 30 plus independent members.

It takes a lot to keep this all volunteer organization going. There is an elected board comprised of a Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary, and Treasurer. There are also elected

positions for Land Management.

Land management plays a major part in the running of the conference. Its decisions govern the use of the land and its also has responsibility to manage the resources that make the runs so comfortable (water, electricity, buildings, etc). The conference has been around for 23 years and will continue into the future only with the involvement of the various clubs who are members like the HOT Bears.

It is with this in mind that a decision was made to use "A Gathering of Clubs" as the theme for **LONE STAR** the most important run of the year as far as Texas Conference of Clubs is concerned. It is through this Memorial Day weekend campout that the majority of the money is raised to keep the campground going. To encourage as many clubs to participate as possible, it has been decided that there will be a \$20 discount to anyone who is a member of the conference. That include YOU- members of H.O.T. Bears. So, your annual \$25 membership is now worth a substantial discount at one of the best runs of the year. It's a great weekend and is the "Cadillac" of the runs.

Back to the Woods is going to be a blast! I encourage you all to attend and return for Lone Star on Memorial Day in 2006.

HOTB- Back to the Woods camp out will be held at the Texas Conference of Clubs (TCC) landsite at Buzzards' Peak from October 7-9, 2005. The landsite is located near Cameron, Texas and is convenient to Austin, San Antonio,

Dallas, and Houston. Facilities include showers, toilets, walk in cooler, ice machine, kitchen, and a pole barn. All facilities and many campsites are handicap accessible.

This is an outdoor, camping event. We expect that all attendees treat the land with respect. Littering and/or causing harm to wildlife will not be tolerated. We expect that you will keep a clean campsite and leave the land as good or better than it was when you arrived.

The entire weekend is provided by volunteers. Treat your servers and hosts accordingly. Jump in and help out if you see something that requires it. Your help will be appreciated and remembered.

For medical emergencies, there will be an on-site EMT. For severe cases, there is a good hospital 15 min away.

Basic fee includes a campsite, meals on Friday evening, all day Saturday, and Sunday morning, entertainment, and a run pin.

Please note that the road into the landsite is not paved and larger RVs will have limited maneuverability.

We attempt to limit attendance to 100 people.

All sites and facilities are provided on a first come, first serve basis at the time of check in.

Official check in starts at Noon on Friday. If you would like to arrive earlier, please call to make arrangements.

By signing this application, you certify that you are at least 21 years of age, and agree not to bring any pets, firearms, explosives or illegal substances of any kind whatsoever on to the Texas Conference of Clubs premises. You agree to comply with all applicable laws of the various governmental agencies during "HOTB- Back to the Woods", and while on the premises. You also agree to be solely responsible for any and all personal property whatsoever that you bring to "HOTB-Back to the Woods". You agree to hold blameless the Texas Conference of Clubs and Heart of Texas Bears, their officers and members, their member clubs, a member of a member club, independent or commercial members, from any and all liability in the event of your accidental injury or death while on the premises.
