Are You Full of PRIDE Yet?

This year, the Heart of Texas Bears are going for the only award we have not received at the annual Pride Parade-The Best Float. We are building it in Leonard Schlueter's garage on a 16 foot flat towed behind a truck. We will

have the convertible in front with the winners of the HOT Bears contest.

We welcome your involvement at creating the float as well as coming out to the parade and walking/riding with your fellow club members. I will ask Kip to do a cheer again (as he has done for the last 4 years). With luck, we will bring home the trophy for our case.

The theme of the parade is "Building com-UNITY." Several ideas have been "floated" out there from a "Bear Under Construction" to "3 Bears In a Tub." The group, headed up by Daniel Trevino, gathered at Leonard Schlueter's last weekend and have come up with a fine design. We have already done the base construction (Thank you Kirk Sinclair and John Finley)- but there is a whole lot more to do. I encourage any of you who are interested in helping out to join in the fun this weekend- June 8th and 9th. We will paint, add flags, and do additional work. On the day of Pride we can gather and put the final touches on it. Email Daniel Trevino or me if you want to join in creating the float. Even if you can't, we look forward to seeing you on the day of the parade. Details will come out in the HOT Bear Happenings.

Recently, I have given a lot of thought about reasons for marching in a gay pride parade- and there have been many reasons. 27 years ago, when I was just coming out, I marched as a demonstration against the government for inaction on AIDS. My club then was ACT UP. Later on, I marched to support social involvement with the group "Open Hands Chicago," a club doing meals-on-wheels for People With AIDS (PWAs) for which I

delivered meals to folks every Thursday for 10 years. When I moved to NYC, I marched along side the leather guyshoping to get a date. I have always been an "out" gay person and never felt outcast for being gay. Frankly, marching for "pride" wasn't much motivation for me.

When I arrived in Austin 4+ years ago, the city's culture of acceptance impressed me. It was not surprising that Austin's parade was small (and newer) compared to other larger cities where tolerance is not as prevalent and gay folks tend to cluster in a specific neighborhood. At the time, I debated if marching with the

neighborhood. At the time, I debated if marching with the HOT Bears was worth the effort. Since I was new to the HOT Bears, I decided to go for social reasons. I was not disappointed-and surprised at how much fun I had. Marching with all the members and doing cheers like "show us your belly!" felt good. I realized that perhaps someone will see us and know there is a club of fine men who volunteer their time and do good works-

I am proud being your president. Come on out and walk with us- just for the fun of it... that's reason enough for me. SHOW US YOUR BELLY! WOOF!
